Position Description, Essential Duties (other duties as assigned):

Essential duties include:

A. Alcohol Service

- Set up and tear down the bar for each event, ensuring that all inventory is properly stocked.
- Prepare alcoholic or non-alcoholic beverages for Happy Days guests.
- Possess an understanding of basic liquid measurements and the ability to follow recipes.
- Control portion sizes in adherence to Conservancy guidelines.
- Check customers' identification and confirm it meets legal drinking age.
- Comply with all beverage service safety regulations.

B. Guest Relations

- By adhering to the Conservancy and NPS policies and procedures, provide excellent customer service to *Extraordinary Spaces* guest groups.
- Create a positive experience for guests while serving weddings, concerts, and other social events in park facilities.
- Access guest needs and preferences and make recommendations.
- Monitor guests' consumption of alcohol and maintain safe levels of service.

C. Sales

- Operate a register and ensure all inventory is accounted for and sales are accurately recorded.
- Manage cash and credit payments, make change, and balance a drawer.
- Positively and accurately communicate the Conservancy and NPS mission to guests, vendors, and potential guest groups resulting in increased good will and awareness for the Park.

D. Other

• Employee must be able to satisfactorily perform the essential duties/functions as outlined in the position's job description.

Minimum Qualifications:

- High school diploma required; TIPS certification preferred.
- Two years of previous bartending experience required.
- Familiarity with event bars and/or craft cocktails preferred.
- Ability to communicate knowledgably and effectively about alcohol.
- Solid working knowledge of measurements and liquid recipes.
- Reliable transportation required.
- Ability to work in a team environment as well as operate independently.
- Ability to respond to common inquiries from customers, staff, visitors and other members of the community.
- The employee must occasionally operate a register, process credit card payments, and use a tablet.
- All employees of the Conservancy for Cuyahoga Valley National Park are required to submit to a background check and/or fingerprint check prior to employment.
- Every Conservancy employee must understand and value racial equity as an
 organizational operating principle and be committed to continued learning on issues related
 to race, equity, diversity, and inclusion.

<u>Status/Pay/Benefits:</u> Part-Time, non-exempt, \$12 per hour plus tips at public programs. \$25 per hour at private events. No benefits associated with this position.
